Food and Yard Waste:

Please place materials in the appropriate container using the guidelines below.

Recycling –

All recyclable materials should be empty, clean, and flattened where possible.

Accepted items include:

- Paper and cardboard
- Paper and plastic take out food containers (including coffee cups)
- Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs, and jars
- Metal food and beverage cans
- Beverage containers

Food & Yard Waste –

The food and yard waste program accepts a wide variety of organic materials, including:

- Food scraps, including meat, bones, dairy products, and food-soiled paper
- Tissues, napkins, paper towels
- Yard waste such as leaves, grass clippings, plants, garden waste, and small branches
- Paper bags and pizza boxes
- BPI-certified compostable bags

Garbage –

Please ensure all garbage is securely bagged and not leaking before placing it in the container.

Items accepted in the garbage include:

- Non-recyclable packaging
- Plastic bags and stretchy plastic film

- Plastic cutlery and straws
- Diapers and wipes
- Pet waste
- Styrofoam packaging and meat trays
- Glass bottles and jars
- Other household waste that is not accepted in recycling or food and yard waste programs
